The McNeil Scholar Program-Detroit is a renewable scholarship program funded by **The Ronald D. & Regina C. McNeil Foundation, Inc.** Awards are made on an annual basis to academically qualified individuals with a financial need.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- U. S. citizen
- Graduating senior of a Detroit Public Schools Community District High School
- Minimum high school academic grade point average (**AGPA**) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Demonstrated financial need
- Acceptance to, with plans to attend, an accredited institution of higher education in the state of Michigan

SELECTION CRITERIA

- **TRANSCRIPT:** An *official* high school transcript complete with cumulative GPA
- **LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** Two (2) letters of recommendation, addressed to **The McNeil Scholar Program-Detroit Selection Committee**, from school staff who have personal knowledge of your
 - Academic record and accomplishments
 - Character
 - Educational goals and objectives
- **PERSONAL STATEMENT:** A personal statement describing yourself and your short and long term educational and career goals and your plan for accomplishing each

- **FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION:** A copy of your **official** 2018-2019 Student Aid Report (**SAR**) complete with Expected Family Contribution (**EFC**)
- **STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES: ACT or SAT**
- **PERSONAL INTERVIEW:** Applicants selected to participate in the interview process will be notified by mail and must complete pre-interview documents
