ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- All **McNeil Scholars** are eligible
- Currently enrolled in an accredited institution of higher education in the state of Michigan
- Minimum GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Demonstrated financial need

SELECTION CRITERIA

- **TRANSCRIPT:** An official college/university transcript complete with cumulative GPA
- **PERSONAL STATEMENT:** A short personal statement describing your successes and challenges of the current school year and your plans for the upcoming school year
- **FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION:** A copy of your **official** 2018–2019 **FAFSA** Student Aid Report (**SAR**) complete with Expected Family Contribution (**EFC**), and a copy of your **official** 2018-2019 Financial Aid Award Letter for from your college or university

- **FINANCIAL PLAN:** updated from previous year. Identify all student loan debt, academic costs and living expenses as well as all sources of income and expected financial assistance for the upcoming school year
- **ACADEMIC PLAN:** updated from previous year. List the specific courses completed and all courses that you plan to take for the upcoming school year
- **ACADEMIC PROGRESS:** Satisfactory progress toward degree completion
- **SCHOLAR CHAT:** All Scholars required are required to participate
