- Graduating senior of Lana'i High School
- Minimum high school academic grade point average (**AGPA**) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale with consideration given to standardized test scores
- Demonstrated financial need
- Acceptance to, with plans to attend an accredited institution of higher education in the United States or one of the five United States Military Academies

SELECTION CRITERIA

- **TRANSCIPT**: An *official* Lana'i High & Elementary School transcript complete with cumulative GPA
- **LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION**: Two (2) letters of recommendation, addressed to **The McNeil Scholar Program-Lana'i Selection Committee**, from school staff who have personal knowledge of your
 - Academic record and accomplishments
 - Character
 - Educational goals and objectives

- **PERSONAL STATEMENT**: A personal statement describing yourself and your short and long term educational and career goals and your plan for accomplishing each
- **FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION**: A copy of your *official* 2023-2024 Student Aid Report (**SAR**) complete with name, address and Expected Family Contribution (**EFC**)
- STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES: ACT or SAT
- **PERSONAL INTERVIEW**: Applicants selected to participate in the interview process will be notified by mail and must complete pre-interview documents
