- LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION: Two (2) letters of recommendation, addressed to The McNeil Scholar Program-Detroit Selection Committee, from school staff who have personal knowledge of your
  - Academic record and accomplishments
  - o Character
  - Educational goals and objectives
- **PERSONAL STATEMENT**: A personal statement describing yourself and your short and long term educational and career goals and your plan for accomplishing each
